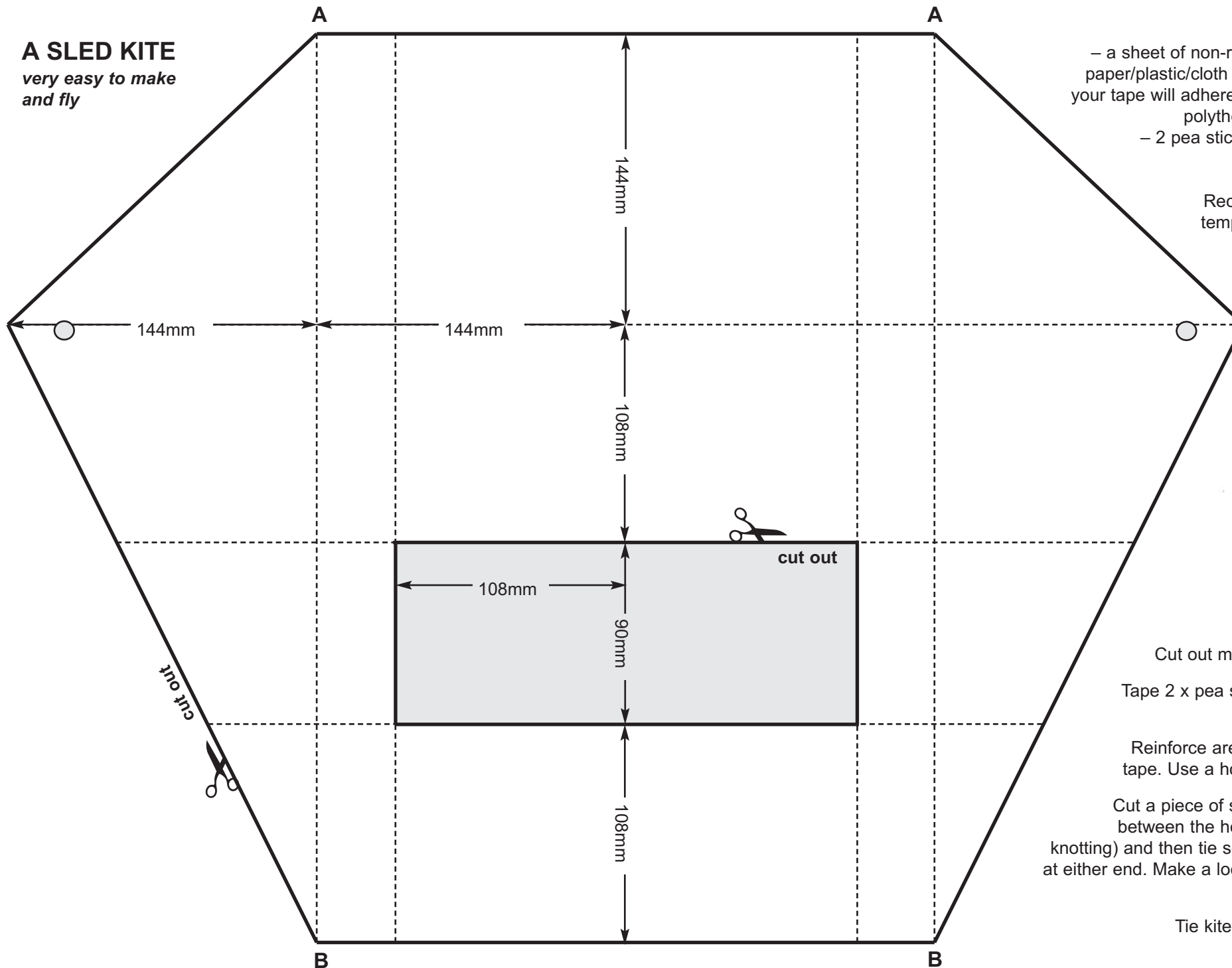


A SLED KITE
*very easy to make
 and fly*



you will need

- a sheet of non-rigid robust material ie paper/plastic/cloth 560x580mm to which your tape will adhere to well - large tough polythene bags are brilliant.
- 2 pea sticks or similar 560 long
- tape and string

Recommend you make a template on a large piece of paper first. A tail is optional but make it a long one in strong wind.



Cut out material using template

Tape 2 x pea sticks to A-B, A-B and trim to length.

Reinforce areas around holes with tape. Use a hole-punch if available.

Cut a piece of string twice the length between the holes (plus a bit for the knotting) and then tie securely through holes at either end. Make a loop in the exact centre of the string.

Tie kite-string to loop and fly.
